The Society of the Missionaries of St. Francis Xavier

On behalf of Society of the Missionaries of St. Francis Xavier, Father Jose will be visiting our parishes for a Mission Appeal on the weekend of August 31/ September 1. The Society of the Missionaries of St. Francis Xavier, is the first indigenous society in India; it was founded in 1887. Today, there are about 350 priests and 10 lay brothers. The main work of the Society is among the Non-Christian people in India and Nepal. The Society works to spread the Gospel in the places where the church has not yet been established. Planting the Gospel in remote place demands both resources and personnel. We work to help the poorest of the poor by establishing schools, orphanages, medicals clinics and other social services. Our Community is growing rapidly; we have more than 200 seminarians in different stages of priestly formation. Our young missionaries are full of enthusiasm and are dedicated to the mission of carrying the joyful and healing message of Jesus to the most remote areas of India and Nepal. Our Missionary Society needs your financial assistance to help build churches, schools, and medical clinics. Your assistance will go a long way to bring the Good News of Jesus to all we meet.
